Scene1 (a house in Nepal)

actor : Binsa, Mom, Grandma

Binsa	Cowshed?	(Surprised)
Mom	Yes. To deal with this, we'll stay there until the blood stops dripping.	
Binsa	Come on, can I just stay here? It smells strange there. Everytime I pass the cowshed, what I want to do is walk away quickly. But now I have to stay there for days? How absurd!	
Grandma	Stop messing around. Tidya has stayed there for two days, too.	(Angry)
Binsa	But I just don't want to go there...	
Grandma	GO AND FIND HER NOW!	(extremely angry)

Sence2 (cowshed)

Actors: Binsa,Claire,Tidya

(Claire passes by the cowshed and sees Binsa and Tidya)

Tidya	Excuse me, Can you help us?	(nervous)
Claire	Sure! How can I help you? Why are you both in the cowshed?	(Curious)
Binsa	This morning, I found that my pants and flat sheet were full of blood and my parents told me to come here.	
Tidya	My mom told me to come to the cowshed, too. I've been bleeding for three days, am I going to die?	(Scared)
Binsa	My mom said this was normal, when she was young she had gone through this, too.	
Tidya	Really?! Then why are we bleeding?	(Surprised,Curious)
Claire	This is a normal physiological phenomenon that only happens on women, called menstruation, it usually lasts 5-7 days. Therefore, you don't have to be worried. By the way, why aren't you doing anything to deal with it?	

Tidya	We use the rags to absorb the blood if we have some. Otherwise, we will just let the blood flow all over.	
Claire OH! I had seen cloth sanitary pads in India, and... I have some cloth sanitary pads right now.	(Thinking)
Binsa+Tidya	Thank you! I think it will be helpful.	
Claire	You are welcome! I'll take you home, and teach you how to make cloth sanitary pads.	(take them home also taught them how to make cloth sanitary napkins)

Scene 3 (a village in Nepal)

Actor : Claire, Binsa's mother, Binsa, Tidya

(Binsa, Tidya and their friends colored many beautiful art works of wombs and made many colorful cloth sanitary pads. Claire displayed them in a small hall.)

Claire	Hey, everyone come closer. I have something to discuss with you! Now you two have used cloth sanitary pads. It's time to promote cloth sanitary pads to let more people know about them!	(excited)
Binsa	Yeah, that's a great idea. But how? Maybe... gather local women and work together in making cloth sanitary pads?	
Claire	Right, invite your family to come over and see these beautiful works of you guys! I will explain everything to them.

Claire	Today we are here to get to know ourselves better and introduce cloth sanitary pads, which can make our lives comfortable and relaxing during our menstruation.

Scene 4 (talk show)

Actor: Claire, Binsa, Binsa's mother, Annie

Narrator	Two years later, they successfully promoted cloth sanitary pads to the world!	
Annie	Welcome back to Annie Show, I'm anchor Annie. In Nepal, making cloth sanitary pads is one of the main industries. Today, let us visit Nepal and check it out.	
Binsa's mother	Yes...And here you should...

Annie	Can I interview you and ask you some questions?
